Ryan White Part B Program fact sheet

The Ryan White Part B Program (Program) is administered by the Utah Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). The Program works through contracted providers to deliver services to people living with HIV/AIDS (PLWH) who meet eligibility requirements.

Eligibility criteria

- · Confirmed HIV status verified by a medical provider
- Reside in Utah and provide proof of a physical address
- Income at or below 500% FPL for case management services
- Income at or below 250% FPL for core and support services
- Income at or below 250% FPL and on antiretroviral therapy for ADAP services

Ryan White services

- AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) is the program within the Utah Ryan White
 Part B Program that provides 2 services: ADAP-Medication Assistance (ADAP-M) and
 ADAP-Health Insurance Assistance (ADAP-I). The "Utah ADAP" refers to both services
 unless otherwise specified.
 - o ADAP-M
 - Provides HIV-related medications to those who qualify.
 - o ADAP-I
 - Provides HIV medication copay assistance and HIV medical visit assistance for those who are enrolled in a spouse, partner, or parent's medical insurance plan.
 - EB-HIPP provides HIV medication copay assistance and HIV medical visit assistance for those who are enrolled in an employer-sponsored

- insurance plan. The program can also assist with the client's portion of the premium.
- Medicare provides HIV medication copay and HIV medical visit assistance for those who are enrolled in a Medicare Part C or D plan. Can assist with monthly premiums.
- COBRA provides HIV medication copay assistance, medical HIV visits assistance, and premium assistance for those who are enrolled in a temporary COBRA plan.
- Marketplace provides HIV medication copay assistance and HIV medical visit assistance for those who are enrolled in a plan through Marketplace. See a case manager if you need help with the monthly premium.
- Medicaid provides medication copay assistance.
- The Direct Pay Insurance (DPI) program provides an insurance plan purchased directly through a program-approved insurance company. The program provides monthly premiums, HIV medication copay, and HIV medical visit assistance. This program is only available for those who don't have access to any other insurance plan.

• Other HIV-related services

- Non-medical and medical case management consists of a case manager who works with someone who needs help with wrap-around services.
- Oral health provides insurance purchased directly through the program-approved dental insurance company. The program provides diagnostic and preventive services.
- Emergency financial assistance provides short-term rental and utility assistance.
- Food vouchers provide help to someone who experiences food insecurity and those who need appropriate nutrition for their medication.. If approved for the food voucher, individual may use this voucher to purchase food.
- Medical transportation provides transportation assistance for HIV medical-related appointments in the form of bus passes, rideshare, and gas vouchers.
- Outpatient ambulatory health services provides HIV-related medical care for those who are uninsured.
- Medical cost sharing assistance provides assistance for medical deductibles or coinsurance and copayments for HIV-related medical care.
